




The title of Germanus' homily was written in upright ogival majuscule script while the text body was in inclined ogival majuscule script in the late eighth or early ninth century.






VAT.LAT.12910, F. 28v (SEC. XI), E.G. OF POLYGONAL ANNOTATION.




VAT.LAT.10696 (SEC. IV-V), E.G. A SMALL ANNOTATION IN OTHER LARGER ANNOTATION.




URB.LAT.9, F. 192V (SEC. XV EX.), E.G. TRANSCRIPTION OF
HEBREW COLOPHON.






